



Charles Murray

Charles Murray was appointed Ombudsman for New Brunswick in June 2013. He was the seventh person to serve as Ombudsman for the province. Initially appointed for a seven-year mandate, his term as Ombud was extended to December 2021.

Mr. Murray is a graduate of Queen's University in Kingston, ON, and Dalhousie Law School in Halifax, NS. He started his career as a private practice lawyer in New Brunswick in the late 1980s. Over the years he served the provincial and federal governments through various roles. He was the Executive Director of the Electoral Boundaries Commission and Policy Manager of Legislation and Professional Regulation for the New Brunswick Department of Health.

He is a member of the New Brunswick Law Society and the Canadian Bar Association, the Epsilon Y's Men Club (Fredericton, NB), and the Confraternity of Saint James. He is a black belt in Kinrosha karate and occasionally walks marathons.

On January 1, 2020, Mr. Murray was appointed Integrity Commissioner for the Province of New Brunswick.
