

Joseph E. Bérubé

New Brunswick's fourth and longest-serving Ombudsman, Jospeh E. Bérubé is a native of Edmundston, New Brunswick. He attended the Arts undergraduate program at the University of Ottawa and studied Law at the University of New Brunswick. He was called to the New Brunswick Bar in 1957 and to the Ontario Bar in 1958.

From 1959 until October 1960, Mr. Bérubé practised law in Sarnia, Ontario and later Grand Falls, New Brunswick. He practiced law in Edmundston, NB until his appointment as Judge of the Provincial Court in September 1965. Mr. Bérubé served in that capacity until May 20, 1976 when he was appointment Ombudsman in June 1976.

Mr. Bérubé is a past-president of the New Brunswick Provincial Court Judge's Association, and the Canadian Association of Provincial Court Judges. He was a member of the New Brunswick Barrister's Society.

Mr. Bérubé retired as Ombudsman in June 1993.
